Fiscal Responsibility	Resident SAU	Attending SAU School or Private School (The school that is enrolling the student in the Infinite Campus Student Information)	Description
Resident of School Unit (for use by public schools only)	A resident student (The resident SAU is the same as the attending SAU)	The public school that the student is attending is in your SAU. AOS's should select the entity as the Resident SAU and NOT the AOS itself. The student is a resident of and is attending Indian Island, Indian Township or Pleasant Point (Beatrice Rafferty School)	A student that is a resident of your school administrative unit and is educated in the school located in your school administrative unit. This may include a student who attends your school unit and meets exception to general residency rules criteria pursuant to 20-A MRSA Section 5205: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sub-section 2 "Other students not living at home", • Sub-section 4 "Students living at light, fog warning or life stations" • Sub-section 5 "Temporary residents".
Paid by Resident SAU or EUT (in-state students) (out-of-state students)	A non-resident student (The resident SAU for this student is not the attending SAU but another SAU or EUT.) A resident student (The "resident" student that is attending an <u>out-of-state</u> school.)	The public or private school that the student is attending is in your SAU or private school. Student is attending an <u>out-of-state</u> school. In this case the Resident SAU enrolls the student and chooses "Non-Maine SAU" under Attending SAU.	A non-resident student for which tuition is paid by another public school administrative unit (SAU) or Education in the Unorganized Territory (EUT) Students that attend an out-of-state school and the resident school administrative unit is paying for this student's "educational" costs (tuition).
Paid by Other Source	A non-resident student (The resident SAU for this student is not the attending SAU but another SAU)	The public or private school that the student is attending is in your SAU or private school.	A non-resident student for which a parent/guardian or private entity is paying for their education (tuition) or students that are residents of another school administrative unit but attend at no charge and have not been transferred under a superintendent's agreement.

100% State/Federal Funding	<p>A non-resident student (The resident SAU for this student is not the attending SAU but another SAU)</p> <p>OR</p> <p>A resident student (The resident SAU is the same as the attending SAU)</p>	<p>The public or private school that the student is attending is in your SAU or private school.</p>	<p>A student whose education is “totally” funded with State and/or Federal dollars and there are no local funds spent for educating these students.</p> <p><i>Examples:</i></p> <p>(1) A state agency client or state ward in an out-of-district special education placement that is paid “totally” by state and/or federal dollars;</p> <p>(2) Students being educated in a preschool program that is “totally” paid by federal and/or state dollars;</p> <p>(3) Students attending Maine School of Science and Mathematics, Governor Baxter School for the Deaf, Arthur R. Gould School/ Long Creek Youth Development Center, or Mountain View Youth Development Center;</p> <p>(4) Students currently attending long-term drug treatment centers Day One Harrod Center or Phoenix Academy; and</p>
<p>Superintendent Agreement</p> <p>(for use by public schools only)</p>	<p>A non-resident student (The resident SAU for this student is not the attending SAU but another SAU.)</p>	<p>The public school that the student is attending is in your SAU.</p>	<p>Students that have been transferred from their resident school administrative unit to the attending school administrative unit under a superintendent’s agreement pursuant to 20-A MRSA Section 5205, sub-section 6 “Transfer students”.</p> <p>Both the receiving unit’s superintendent and the resident sending unit’s superintendent <u>must</u> agree to this transfer. These students will be counted in the receiving (attending) school administrative unit for subsidy. No tuition is paid for this student.</p>
<p>Paid by Maine Indian Education</p> <p>(MIE)</p>	<p>A <u>non-resident student</u> (The resident SAU for this student is not the attending SAU but another SAU.)</p> <p>A non-resident student (The resident SAU for this student is not the attending SAU but another SAU.)</p>	<p>The SAU that the student is attending is Indian Island, Indian Township or Pleasant Point (Beatrice Rafferty School) and the student is not a resident of the MIE unit.</p> <p>The public or private school that the student is attending is in your SAU or private school.</p>	<p>A non-resident student for which tuition is paid by Maine Indian Education. Student must be listed under Ethnicity as "American Indian or Native Alaskan" AND have answered “NO” under the Hispanic ethnicity question.</p>

Maine Public Charter School Funding (for use by charter schools only)	Resident SAU and Resident Town are where the students' parents/guardians reside.	The Maine Charter School in which the student is attending.	For students who are attending Maine Charter Schools as pursuant to 20-A MRSA Section 2413-A, sub-section 5.
Internationally Tuitioned-In Student	Resident SAU is Non-Maine SAU and Resident Town is Non-Maine Town.	The public or private school that the student is attending.	For privately paid students who reside outside of the United States. Not to be confused with "Foreign Exchange" students.
Paid by Governor Baxter School for the Deaf	Resident SAU and Resident Town are where the students' parents/guardians reside.	Governor Baxter School for the Deaf or Portland Public Schools.	Only to be used by The Governor Baxter School for the Deaf or Portland Public Schools.
