Directions:

The Hutchinson Center is located on Route 3 in Belfast. If you are driving east from Augusta, as you come into Belfast on Route 3, watch on the right for the Belfast City sign. (There is a stop sign logo on it.) Hutchinson Center is on the right, just past the sign for Sweetser Children's Services, which is on the right. Just past the stop sign, still on the right, is a large University of Maine Hutchinson Center sign. Turn in and follow the driveway into the parking lot.

If you are driving north from Camden, exit Route 1 when you enter Belfast as it intersects with Route 3. Take the left and go about a half a mile on Route 3 heading towards Augusta. You will Pass EBS, Bank of America, Dairy Queen and other businesses, on the right. The Hutchinson Center is on the left. The driveway is directly across from the Belfast Self-Storage building (tan and maroon). Take the left into our driveway, and follow the road into the parking lot.

If you are driving south from Searsport, take Route 1 until it exits onto Belfast at Route 3. You will see Reny's on your right. Take the right onto Route 3, heading west towards Augusta for about a half of a mile. You will pass EBS, Bank of America, Dairy Queen and other businesses on the left. The Hutchinson Center is on the left. The driveway is directly across from the Belfast Self-Storage building (tan and maroon). Take the left into our driveway, and follow the road into the parking lot.


