Requirements and Definitions. A state employee or an independent agency employee must register at the office of the Commission within 15 days of the convening of a regular legislative session if: 1) the employee is directed by the head of a department or agency to lobby or monitor legislation for that department or agency or 2) the employee reasonably is expected to monitor legislation on behalf of the department or agency for more than 20 hours during the session. "Monitoring legislation" includes attending legislative hearings and sessions regarding a legislative action.

"State employee or state agency employee" means employees of the executive branch, the judicial branch, the Department of the Attorney General, the Department of the Secretary of State, the Department of the Treasurer and any employee who directly or indirectly represents an entity listed in Title 5, Chapter 379.
