 - 1. Update on 2020 Southern Coast LiDAR timeline.
 - a. Will this data be available to funding partners before it is made publicly available?
 - i. MEGIS will get a copy once USGS has approved it, before it is made publicly available, and will try to get it to their funding partners ahead of time.
 - 2. 2021 LiDAR capture status update:
 - a. 38.5% captured in spring 2021
 - b. 61.5% to be captured in fall 2021
 - 3. 2022 USGA BAA
 - a. The estimated total is \$450K and the board had previously allocated up to \$500K. We're looking at approximately \$250K at this point.
 - b. Motion to authorize the Finance Committee to determine the amount for LiDAR project made by Betsy Fitzgerald, seconded by Leticia van Vuuren.
