

Maine Wildlife Park Group Visit Expectations

Groups of 18 or more:

RESERVATIONS ARE REQUIRED for all groups of over 18 visitors planning to visit Maine Wildlife Park. Please call the MWP office at 207.822.6460 or Email: mainewildlifepark@maine.gov

Admission Fees:

Payment is expected on the day of your visit. Cash or check made out to Maine Wildlife Park. If you require an invoice, arrangements must be made with the MWP office before your visit by Calling: 207.822.6460 or Emailing: <u>mainewildlifepark@maine.gov</u>. **Reminder that Maine Wildlife Park** <u>DOES NOT</u> accept credit/debit cards.

Chaperones:

Group chaperones are eligible for the discounted group rate. To do so, the chaperone must clearly communicate to the admission attendant which group they are with at the time of entry.

*It is imperative for the chaperones to pay at the admissions gate and <u>wait inside the</u> park in the designated area.

Parking:

All buses <u>MUST</u> go directly to the bus parking area and park <u>PRIOR TO</u> <u>UNLOADING</u> any passengers. After parking, ONE representative of the group should make their way to the admission gate to make the arrangements for entry, then return to the bus to lead the group for park entry as a single party. Please guide the group to stay in the appropriate indicated walkways.

Picnic Area:

For the safety of all our visitors, we recommend bringing all your lunch and supplies when entering the park. There are many picnic tables available on a first come basis, to leave your lunch and supplies. Please bring trash bags for your rubbish and carry in/carry out your trash to the best of your ability. No climbing on trees, fences, or gates.

Animals:

Treat the park and our animals with respect. <u>NO</u> screaming, clapping, yelling, whistles, or any other loud noises. Groups must be kept composed and considerate of our animals and other visitors throughout their visit.
