
Shallow Pond is located west of Jim Pond. It has no major inlet and its outlet flows northeast into the South Branch of the Dead River. It is a shallow pond and subject to high water temperatures in the summer months. Water quality for coldwater fish species is poor.

Yellow perch are well established, but do not grow to a large size; few exceed 10 inches. Their role as a competitor of trout further detracts from Shallow Pond being considered for trout management. Stocking is not recommended.


Shallow Pond is reached by a trail from a paper company road off Route 27 north of Eustis. The pond is open fishing with general law in both the summer and winter seasons.
