Area - 19 acres

Principal fisheries: Smallmouth bass, largemouth bass, chain pickerel

Evans Pond is a small, shallow, warmwater pond with a very marshy shoreline.

Both largemouth and smallmouth bass were illegally introduced into Evans Pond during the early 1980's. Anglers now report 'fast' fishing for bass, but unfortunately the majority of these fish are of sub-legal size. The habitat is best suited for largemouth bass and would probably provide a better fishery if the smallmouth bass were not present.
