Management of Hamilton Pond is limited to warmwater species due to the severe oxygen deficiency below 15 feet.

Rainbow smelt have become established since the original survey was completed in 1953. It is unclear whether the smelt population is large enough to provide a hook and line fishery.

A turnout along State Route 135 provides access to Hamilton Pond.


