

Principal fisheries: Largemouth bass, white perch

Fresh Pond is a shallow warmwater pond that should continue to be managed for largemouth bass. Largemouth bass were introduced into the pond in 1964. The regional fishery office had received many outstanding reports on the bass fishery a few years after the introduction with bass up to 6 pounds.

Brook trout were experimentally stocked in the early 1970's, but when they failed to provide a fishery stocking was discontinued.
