Access to Round pond can be obtained by launching a canoe at the Seven Tree Pond landing and canoeing up the outlet of Round Pond under State Route 235.

Although Round Pond lacks sufficient water quality for the successful management of coldwater species, the pond does produce some warmwater fishing opportunities. Largemouth bass were introduced in 1967 and thrive in the thick weedy brush cover along the shores and produces some larger fish. The sea-run alewife population contributes to the fishery as the juveniles are used as a food source by other fish species.
