
Principal Fisheries: white perch, chain pickerel

Fields Pond is a shallow, weedy pond with large populations of warmwater gamefish. Its perch and pickerel fisheries are especially popular with Maine's "younger generation" of fishermen. Many youngsters in the Bangor-Brewer have received their initiation as fishermen here.

This pond should be managed for white perch and pickerel. No stocking of any kind is recommended.
