Pleasant Lake provides ideal habitat for warmwater species and should continued being managed for such. Smallmouth bass were introduced in 1960 and now a self-sustaining population exists. Largemouth bass and black crappie have immigrated from Sebasticook Lake located downstream and now provide fisheries.

There are 3 access sites on Pleasant Lake, 2 of these are improved sites where a trailerable boat can be launched.
