Caesar Pond is an extremely shallow pond so choked with aquatic plants that use of a boat and motor is nearly impossible.

An experimental introduction of largemouth bass was undertaken in 1955 by the Maine Fish and Game Department. Since this introduction severe oxygen deficiencies beneath the ice have resulted in fish kills. Biologists were unable to establish the presence of any fish in Caesar Pond in 1963.


Conditions are not now conducive to the successful management of any fish. No further stockings should be made.
