
Physical Characteristics

Lily Pond is a shallow, weedy, muddy-bottomed pond with sphagnum and other bog plants lining the shores. The predominant fisheries are for pickerel and hornpout, and this pond is reported to be popular among ice fishermen.

Access to Lily Pond is by foot trail, with the best approach located at the north end.

No stocking is recommended.
