## Physical Characteristics

Shaw Pond is located north of Flagstaff Lake. Its major inlet enters the west end of the pond and its outlet flows east into nearby Lower Shaw Pond. The pond's shoreline is mostly undeveloped.

Water quality in Shaw Pond is poor for coldwater gamefish. Water temperatures reach critically high levels during the warm summer months. Salmonid spawning habitat is not present around the pond. The pond is not stocked.

Shaw Pond is accessible via logging roads from around either the east or west side of Flagstaff Lake. The pond is open to general law in the summer and closed to fishing in the winter.
