


## Physical Characteristics

Area - 6 acres

Maximum depth - 28 feet

Principal fishery: Baitfish

Temperatures:

Surface - 69°F  
27 feet - 44°F

Tibbetts Pond is located west of Old Bluff Mountain. It has no inlet or outlet. The pond's shoreline is undeveloped.

Water quality in Tibbetts Pond is poor for coldwater gamefish. During the summer months upper level water temperatures get critically high while dissolved oxygen levels are low in the cool deeper basin. It is not stocked.

Tibbetts Pond is accessible via Route 16. The pond is open to fishing under general law in the summer and closed to ice fishing.
