Common Eider Management Goal and Objectives 2001 – 2016

Adopted by MDIFW Commissioner and Advisory Council August 28, 2001

GOAL

Increase the number of Common Eiders nesting in Maine and the public's knowledge and appreciation of eiders and their habitats.

<u>Population Objective</u>: By 2016, increase the number of nesting Common Eiders in Maine by 20%.

Habitat Objective 1: Increase the number of Common Eider nesting islands in conservation ownership by 1 per year until 2016.

<u>Habitat Objective 2</u>: Working with partners, develop investigations to understand issues associated with (1) recreational use of Common Eider nesting islands and (2) commercial harvesting of resources in Common Eider brood-rearing and feeding habitats.

<u>Outreach Objective</u>: By 2003, develop and implement, in conjunction with partners, an outreach program to promote an understanding and appreciation of Common Eiders and their habitat requirements in Maine.
