

Upper Macwahoc Lake, a very shallow, warmwater lake, is filling with silt and nearing the end of its productive life over much of its area. A small area of the lake provides habitat for existing warmwater species, and pickerel provide a limited fishery.

Brook trout are present in the upper reaches of the inlet. Poor water quality and pickerel predation reduce trout survival in the lake.
