Suggested Management

Sweets Pond should be managed for pickerel and white perch fishing. A serious oxygen depletion in the colder, deeper waters and the absence of suitable spawning areas precludes the possibility of maintaining a trout or salmon population either by habitat improvement or stocking.

No stocking is recommended.
