Suggested Management

First Debsconeag Lake should be managed for lake trout. Water quality is excellent for this species at all depths.

The limited salmon fishery is probably supported by migrants from the West Branch of the Penobscot River, since there are no suitable salmon spawning tributaries to First Debsconeag Lake. Lake trout spawning areas are adequate.

Liberalized fishing for white perch is recommended.
