
Maximum depth - 6 feet

Upper Island Pond is relatively shallow with about equal water temperatures at all depths. Trout must seek limited areas of spring influence when pond temperatures become warm.

Yellow perch are abundant in the pond and are serious competitors with brook trout.

Marginal water quality and heavy competition seriously limit the capacity of the pond to support a significant trout fishery.
