North Meyers Pond is located south of the Great Heath. It is surrounded by extensive blueberry barrens. Access is via rough and poorly defined gravel roads.


An experimental brook trout stocking program was terminated in the late 1980's. The landowner of the property adjacent to the pond complained of littering and vandalism to his camp. Further stockings could not be justified in the face of such irresponsible behavior by anglers. The pond is currently managed as a source of live bait for bait fishermen.


