

Commercial Whitewater Rafting Monthly Report Form

Directions:

Each outfitter is required to report monthly to the Maine Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife the number of raft passengers (excluding guides) carried each day on each rapidly flowing river. In accordance with Title 12 12912-1(A), outfitters must pay a fee of **\$2.00** for each raft passenger listed on the report and must also report all other commercial passengers (i.e. canoes and kayaks). Both the report and the fee must be submitted by the 30th day of the month following the month in which the passengers were carried.

Rapidly flowing river means the following stretches of river: the Kennebec River between Harris Station and West Forks, The West Branch of the Penobscot River between McKay Station and Pockwockamus Falls; the Dead River from its confluence with Spencer Stream to The Forks at a flow level of 2,400 cfs or higher; the Rapid River from the outlet of Lower Richardson Lake to 3/4 miles upstream from Umbagog Lake, and the Magalloway River from Aziscohos Lake to the first Route 16 bridge west of Aziscohos Lake at a flow level of 800 cfs or higher, and the South Branch of the Penobscot River from Canada Falls Dam to the bridge on the Northern Road just prior to Pittston Farm at a flow level of 500 cfs or higher.

Penalties for failure to comply with this provision include non renewal, revocation, or suspension of an outfitter's license or allocation or both, or may subject the outfitter to a civil penalty of up to \$5,000. In addition, outfitters with an allocation are penalized in the allocation system for each late payment or report.
