At its meeting on October 10, 2006, you appeared before the Board and asked to be released from the terms of your Consent Agreement and to be granted an unconditional license.

The Board listened to your statements and determined that you have learned from your past actions and should be granted an unconditional license. You are hereby released from the requirements of that Consent Agreement which is dated December 12, 2000. Your license status will be converted to active, unconditioned as of October 10, 2006.

The Board agreed with your report that before attempting to resume any active patient treatment that a period of mentoring or re-learning would be necessary. The Board expects that you will honor that statement and obtain significant clinical update mentoring or training should you choose to re-enter clinical practice.

This document is a Consent Agreement and Order, effective when signed by all parties, regarding reinstatement to a conditional license to practice medicine in the State of Maine. The parties to the Consent Agreement are Donald Trumbull, M.D. (the "Licensee"), the State of Maine Board of Licensure in Medicine (the "Board") and the Maine Department of Attorney General.

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

Donald Trumbull, M.D., was initially licensed to practice medicine in the State of Maine in 1983. On July 14, 1998, Dr. Trumbull signed a Consent Agreement with the Board in which he agreed to revocation of his Maine license for one year. The Agreement also contained requirements of a psychiatric evaluation and performance of 500 hours of public service. Dr. Trumbull has satisfied the terms of the 1998 Consent Agreement.

In October, 2000, Dr. Trumbull filed an application for reinstatement. The Board considered the application and decided to grant a conditional license to practice medicine in the State of Maine.

CONDITIONS OF LICENSURE

The Licensee, the Board and the Department of Attorney General agree and understand that maintenance of his license shall be conditioned upon Dr. Trumbull's compliance with the following conditions of licensure. Failure to comply with any of the following conditions shall

irrevocably result in the nonrenewal or revocation of Dr. Trumbull's license to practice medicine in the State of Maine.

1. The Licensee will not see, care for or treat minor female patients.
2. The Licensee agrees to continue in treatment with Sue Righthand, Ph.D. until the therapist and the Licensee mutually agree to termination. Dr. Righthand will provide the Board with quarterly reports of Dr. Trumbull's progress.
3. The Licensee agrees not to practice medicine as a solo practitioner. If the Licensee practices as part of a group or as an employed physician, he must tell his partners or his employer of the terms of this Agreement and the prior Consent Agreement.
4. The Board will not consider any requests for modification of this Agreement until December, 2002.
5. Dr. Trumbull agrees to waive his right to a hearing before the Board or any court regarding all terms and conditions of this Consent Agreement. Dr. Trumbull agrees and understands that he has the right to the advice of legal counsel with respect to the signing of this Consent Agreement.

I, DONALD TRUMBULL, M.D., HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THE FOREGOING CONSENT AGREEMENT. I UNDERSTAND THAT BY SIGNING, I WAIVE CERTAIN RIGHTS. I SIGN IT VOLUNTARILY, WITHOUT ANY THREAT OR PROMISE. I UNDERSTAND THAT THIS CONSENT AGREEMENT CONTAINS

THE ENTIRE AGREEMENT AND THERE IS NO OTHER AGREEMENT OF ANY
KIND, VERBAL, WRITTEN OR OTHERWISE.

This Consent Agreement is entered into by Donald Trumbull, M.D., the State of Maine Board of Licensure in Medicine (the "Board") and the State of Maine Department of Attorney General pursuant to 10 M.R.S.A. § 8003(5)(B), 32 M.R.S.A. § 3282-A(1).

STATEMENT OF FACTS

1. Donald Trumbull, M.D., has been licensed to practice medicine in the State of Maine since 1983. At all times relevant to this agreement, Dr. Trumbull was practicing by himself in a general medical practice in Tenant's Harbor, Maine.

2. Patient A, a minor female, was treated by Dr. Trumbull from approximately 1988 through 1992. Dr. Trumbull occasionally examined Patient A without her mother or a nurse present.

3. When she was in the eighth grade, Patient A alleged that Dr. Trumbull fondled her breasts and conducted an inappropriate breast examination. Patient A also alleged that he performed a pelvic exam without gloves after telling Patient A that he was going to do a rectal examination.

4. Patient B, a minor female, was seen by Dr. Trumbull in October, 1990. During that examination, which was conducted without anyone else in the room, Dr. Trumbull performed a pelvic examination without using a glove. He also

kissed the patient's breasts while he was doing an examination.

5. Patient A filed a complaint with the Board. The Board issued a complaint on its own motion based on the information related to Patient B. The Board ordered an adjudicatory hearing to decide the issues of unprofessional conduct and incompetence based on inappropriate physical examinations and sexual misconduct.

AGREEMENT

In lieu of proceeding to an adjudicatory hearing in which the Board would seek revocation of Dr. Trumbull's license to practice medicine, the parties agree to the following:

1. The events described in the Statement of Facts constitute sexual misconduct as defined by Chapter 10 of the rules of the Board.
2. The Board has jurisdiction over Dr. Trumbull and over the disciplinary matters raised by the pending complaints.
3. Dr. Trumbull agrees to revocation of his Maine license for one year. The year of revocation will begin on the effective date of this Agreement.
4. Dr. Trumbull will undergo a psychiatric/psychological evaluation to be performed by an examiner chosen by the Board at the time of the signing of this Agreement.
5. Dr. Trumbull will perform five hundred (500) hours of public service during the year in which his medical license is revoked. That public service will be approved and reviewed by the Board.


6. Dr. Trumbull agrees to waive his right to a hearing before the Board or any Court regarding all terms and conditions of this Consent Agreement. Dr. Trumbull has had the advice of legal counsel with respect to the negotiation and signing of this Consent Agreement.

I, DONALD TRUMBULL, M.D., HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THE FOREGOING CONSENT AGREEMENT. I UNDERSTAND THAT BY SIGNING IT, I WAIVE CERTAIN RIGHTS. I SIGN IT VOLUNTARILY, WITHOUT ANY THREAT OR PROMISE. I UNDERSTAND THAT THIS CONSENT AGREEMENT CONTAINS THE ENTIRE AGREEMENT AND THERE IS NO OTHER AGREEMENT OF ANY KIND.


