What to do if you are bitten by a tick

If you are bitten by a tick, notify your supervisor ASAP. Your supervisor will contact Human Resources to set up a medical appointment for you immediately with a Workers' Compensation occupational medical provider. Let the medical provider know that you found a tick attached to your body. The risk of Lyme disease is greatly reduced if the tick is removed within the first 36 hours. Remember, if Lyme disease is discovered early, your medical provider can treat it before it becomes a serious problem.
