NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS  
MANDATORY PRE-BID MEETING**

A **mandatory pre-bid meeting** will occur at the Maine DOT Building, Child Street, Augusta, Maine, Main Conference Room, at 1:00 o'clock P.M. (prevailing time) to 4:00 P.M. on March 26, 2008. Attendance at this meeting is a requirement for bid submittal on the contract (PIN 15114.00) for this work to be advertised sometime in April 2008. Failure to attend this meeting will be considered a **Non-Curable Bid Defect**.

Description: Maine Federal Aid Project No. IM-1511(400)E, PIN 15114.00

Location: In Kennebec, Sagadahoc, and Cumberland Counties, the project is located on the southbound lanes of I-295 beginning 0.07 miles south of the Exit 49 off-ramp and extending southerly 21.57 miles to 0.14 miles south of the Exit 28 off-ramp.

Outline of Work: Concrete rubblization, 8" HMA overlay, inslope rehabilitation, culvert replacement, bridge rehabilitations, and other incidental work for the northern 17.84 miles.

HMA overlay, bridge rehabilitations, and other incidental work for the southern 3.73 miles.


Concrete Rubblization	– 290,000 SY
Hot Mix Asphalt	– 170,000 tons
Guardrail	– 25,000 LF new+50 End treatments
Inslope Rehabilitation	– 227,000 LF
