Dear Sir/Ms:

Please make the following change to the Bid Documents:

Within "the 2007 Contractor's Prequalification Application for Marine Dock and Facilities Repair and Rehabilitation" on page 4 of the application and page 12 of the book, under Section 5 "Insurance" DELETE the statement: "*A Certificate of insurance must be submitted to the Contract Procurement Office prior to execution of a contract.*" and REPLACE it with the following statement: "*A Certificate of insurance for Commercial General Liability, Automobile and Workers Compensation must be submitted to the Contract Procurement Office prior to execution of a contract.*" Make this change in pen and ink.

The following question has been received.

**Question:** I would like clarification on insurance requirements of page 12 (aka page 4) Item #5. I do not see applicability of Professional Liability nor owners & Contractors Protective Liability ( Items a & e) for neither applies to repair work. Do you concur??

**Response:** In order to conduct most Marine dock and facilities repairs, Professional Liability and Owners & Contractors Protective Liability will not be required. The Department will not require proof of these in order to execute a contract. There may be a project in which one of these could be required such as a temporary structure.

Consider this change and information prior to submitting your bid on April 4, 2007.
