Make the following changes to the Bid Documents:

In the Bid Book, "NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS" (page 1), **CHANGE** the description under "Location:" to read as follows; **Location: In Oxford County, project 010020.10 is located in Norway on Rte. 117 from approx. 1.6 km south of the Old Stage Road extending northerly approx. 1.7 km. Project STP-1568(600)E is located in Paris on Rte. 26 from Alpine St. extending approx. 0.15 km easterly.** Make this change in pen and ink.

In the Bid Book, after the "NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS" (page 1), **INSERT** the attached "NOTICE" for DBE utilization.

The following question has been received:

Question: Are there any WBE/DBE requirements for this project? The bid book includes the "State Project" insert and there is no DBE Notice page in the front of the book?

Response: The Paris job is Federal and the Norway job is State Funded. WBE/DBE requirements do apply.

Question: How is the pavement removal being paid for?

Response: Removal of existing pavement is included in Item 203.20 "common exc."

Question: The Special Provisions include Section 606, Guardrail, but there is none called out in the schedule of items, please clarify?


Response: There are 20 "single wood post" (Item No. 606.47) in the Schedule of items. Wood posts are addressed in "SPECIAL PROVISION, SECTION 606, GURADRAIL".
