The following question has been received:

**Question:** Other than a traffic light on each end, there is very little information on traffic control. Is the Contractor to provide a detour or temporary culvert?

**Response:** The intent is to maintain two-way traffic as long as possible. The temporary traffic signals will need to be installed and utilized when roadway width becomes too narrow to maintain two-way traffic overnight. This will happen while removing the existing structure and installing the new. In addition, a detour or widening of the existing roadway may be necessary to maintain traffic as the structure is replaced. All traffic shall be maintained in accordance with Section 652, Maintenance of Traffic. The Contractor will need to maintain stream flow at all times per Special Provision Section 656, #13. The Contractor will also be required to work in the dry per Special Provision Section 656, #11.

Consider this information prior to submitting your bid on **June 11, 2008**.
