Make the following changes to the Bid Documents:

In the Bid Book (page 38), "General Notes" **DELETE** note number 9 in its entirety. Make this change with pen and ink.

In the Bid Book, after page 42, **ADD** the attached 2010 Fair Minimum Wage Rates, one page, dated January 14, 2010.

In the Bid Book (page 55), "Special Provision, Section 107, Prosecution and Progress, (Contract Time)", in paragraph's 5, 6 and 7 **DELETE** all references to July 12, 2010, and **REPLACE** with **July 8, 2010**. Make this change with pen and ink.

The following questions have been received:

**Question:** I was unable to locate any wage rate information in the proposal book are there certified wages for this project?

**Response:** Yes, please see the attached wage rates as referenced above.

**Question:** Special Provision Section 107 calls out a meeting on 7/12/2010 to conduct an inspection with the Contractor / Resident/ Town Representative. All repairs / issues that arise as a result of that meeting must be completed by 7/14/2010 or LD'S of \$1500.00 per CD will be assessed. What happens if the list of repairs / issues is large enough that it can not be completed in the time allowed before LD's will be assessed?

**Response:** Please see above change regarding new date.



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**Question:** General note # 9 states that if foundation material is required under culverts it will be paid for as granular borrow, but general note # 18 states that it is incidental to the 603 items. Which note is correct?

**Response:** Note 18 is correct, Granular Borrow will be considered incidental to the 603 items.


Welders are classified in the trade to which the welding is incidental.

Apprentices - The minimum wage rate for registered apprentices are those set forth in the standards and policies of the Maine State Apprenticeship and Training Council for approved apprenticeship programs.

Posting of Schedule - Posting of this schedule is required in accordance with 26 MRSA §1301 et. seq., by any contractor holding a State contract for construction valued at \$50,000 or more and any subcontractors to such a contractor.

Appeal - Any person affected by the determination of these rates may appeal to the Commissioner of Labor by filing a written notice with the Commissioner stating the specific grounds of the objection within ten (10) days from the filing of these rates with the Secretary of State.
