

**MAINE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION**

**Description of State Maintenance lines established for  
delimiting the urban area of**

**CUMBERLAND, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, MAINE**

Commencing at a point on the Falmouth town line and on the easterly side of Route 1 and traveling northly along the easterly right-of-way of Route 1 to the intersection of Tuttle Road, thence northwesterly along the southerly right-of-way of Tuttle Road to the intersection of Route 9, thence south along the easterly right-of-way of Route 9 to the Winn Road intersection, thence crossing Route 9 and traveling north along the westerly right-of-way of Route 9 to the intersection of Route 9 and Blanchard Road, thence northwest along the southerly right-of-way of Blanchard Road to the intersection of Skillin Road, thence southwest along the southerly right-of-way of Skillin Road continuing across Route 26/100 and along the southerly right-of-way of Blackstrap Road to the Falmouth town line, thence crossing Blackstrap Road and along the northerly right-of-way of Blackstrap Road northeast across Route 26/100 and continuing along the northerly right-of-way of Skillin Road to the intersection of Blanchard Road, thence crossing Blanchard Road and southeasterly along the northerly right-of-way of Blanchard Road to the Main Street (Route 9) intersection, thence northeast along the westerly right-of-way of Main Street (Route 9) to the North Yarmouth town line, thence across Main Street (Route 9) and traveling southwest along the easterly right-of-way of Main Street (Route 9) to the intersection of Tuttle Road, thence southeast along the northerly right-of-way of Tuttle Road to the intersection of Route 1, thence northeasterly along the easterly right-of-way of Route 1 to the Yarmouth town line, thence southeast along the Yarmouth/Cumberland town lines to the waters of Casco Bay, thence southerly along the shore line to the Falmouth town line, thence northwest along the Falmouth town line to the point of beginning.

NOTE: Bridges, if any, bisected by the State Maintenance Line are in the rural area.
