**Description of State Maintenance lines established for
delimiting the urban area of**

SOUTH BERWICK, YORK COUNTY, MAINE

Beginning at a point at the northeast corner of the intersection of Farmgate Road and Dow Highway (Route 236), thence across Dow Highway (Route 236), thence northwest along the southerly right-of-way of Dow Highway (Route 236) to the intersection of Main Street (Route 4), thence southwest along the easterly right-of-way of Main Street (Route 4) to a point along the South Berwick town line in the Salmon Falls River (bridge #3027), thence along the town line in a northerly direction to a point in the river that intersects the South Berwick/Berwick town lines (bridge #5700), thence northeasterly and easterly along the South Berwick/Berwick town lines to a point on the west side of Driscoll Lane, thence southerly along the westerly right-of-way of Driscoll Lane to the intersection of Portland Street (Route 4), thence across Portland Street (Route 4), thence southwesterly along the easterly right-of-way of Portland Street (Route 4) to the intersection of Route 236 and Main Street (Route 4), thence southerly along the easterly right-of-way of Route 236 to the point of beginning.

NOTE: Bridges, if any, bisected by the State Maintenance Line are in the rural area.
