This letter serves as evidence of assurance by the State of Maine Department of Transportation (MaineDOT) and Efficiency Maine that matching funds for the 2024-2025 Charging and Fueling Infrastructure Discretionary Grant application "Chargers to Promote Resilience (CPR) a Recharge Maine Project" submitted by MaineDOT are committed and will be provided.

MaineDOT, in coordination with Efficiency Maine is seeking \$15,000,000 in FY 2024-2025 Charging and Fueling Infrastructure Discretionary Grant Corridor funding, matched by \$3,750,000 in state, local and private funds. The individual projects that make up this effort are included in the statewide Electric Vehicle Charging Infrastructure Plan and will be included in MaineDOT's *Work Plan*, and in the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) upon award. It is consistent with MaineDOT's long-range plan. MaineDOT is committed to providing these matching funds to the Federal funds requested.
