The Portland, Maine UA has a population of 203,914, further designating the Project *urban.*<sup>3</sup> (Under the Census Bureau's new definition of urban, North Windham remains urban with a population of 10,271 and 5,183 housing units as well as land area of 14.0 square miles.<sup>4</sup>)
