My name is James and I am a Senior Tax Examiner for Maine Revenue Services. As a fellow state agent in Augusta, I greatly appreciate all of your hard work and dedication to the state of Maine and its people.

I wanted to briefly provide my input on the rail discussion as it's something I feel passionate about. There are a couple key reasons why I feel it's crucial we restore the rail for passenger purposes:

- 1) Augusta is undergoing a resurgence in the public eye. The city's reputation is improving as its economy improves, businesses arrive, and simply more things to do exist. A functional rail would bolster all of these areas. Augusta is gaining its momentum and a project like this could set it over the edge in terms of trendiness and public opinion. The increase in visitors and commuters may prove significant.

Greetings again,

I just recently wrote to you about why you shouldn't rip up the Lower Road rail and that a rail with trail option must be approved as a compromise with the trail advocates with still preserving the option of passenger rail to Bangor via Brunswick.

I forgot to mention in my previous note that if you keep the Lower Road for passenger rail, you wouldn't have to share it with CSX, which would eliminate a lot of delays that happen to passenger trains that run on tracks owned by freight railroads. You also would be able to maintain the tracks to as high of a quality as you want without being limited by what a freight railroad wants.

Please pass this note onto the Lower Road Advisory Council and I hope you will consider my ideas/information provided and that a compromise can be found that will make both groups happy.

Greetings, Nathan

My name is Jared Bamford, and I am a railroad conductor here in the state of Maine. I worked for CSX/Pan Am Railways for 11 years out of Rigby Yard in South Portland and currently work for Amtrak on the Downeaster. What I am about to say is strictly my opinion only. I am speaking based on my own personal experiences, and am not speaking for CSX or the Downeaster/NNEPRA.

I think it's a horrible idea to remove the Lower Road rail and that a rail with trail option needs to be approved. During the webinar, a councilman from Bangor stated that 99% of the track that gets ripped up for a trail never gets put back in place. It certainly hasn't happened anywhere in New England during my 35 years on this earth. If you rip up the rail, you're asking for an extremely hard fight from the trail advocates if you later decide you want to put rail back in. A compromise needs to happen in this situation.

If you decide you want passenger rail to Bangor in the future, using the "Back Road" aka the line thru New Gloucester, Auburn, Lewiston, Winthrop, etc operationally doesn't make any sense anymore since it was decided to build a layover facility in Brunswick. With the Lower Road being ripped up, you'd have to head south/west 15 miles to Royal Junction so that you could then head north on the Back Road toward Bangor. For it to operationally make any sense at all, you'd have to do a revenue trip from Brunswick to Portland to start the day, drop off/pickup passengers in Portland, and then head up the Back Road toward Lewiston/Waterville/Bangor. Deciding to use the Back Road instead of the Lower Road, you'd save money in the short term because of less upfront costs and a freight railroad that may be willing to put money towards it as well, but in the long run I think you'd spend more money operationally on the Back Road vs Lower Road. Going from Brunswick to Portland before starting a trip to Bangor would add roughly 25-27 miles per train each day. May not seem like much in the short term, but in the long term it adds up with equipment maintenance, fuel costs, added hours worked by the train crews, etc.

I have also had a lot of people on the train in Brunswick tell me that they drove there from Augusta, Waterville, Bangor, etc and really want the Downeaster to be extended further north.

If you use the Lower Road for passenger rail, you wouldn't have to share it with CSX and would remove all of the delays passenger trains have when they operate on tracks owned by freight railroads. You could also maintain the tracks to as high of a quality and speed as you want without being limited by the opinions of a freight railroad.

Thank you for reading this and I hope a compromise can be found to appease both the people that want a trail, and those who want more passenger rail in Maine.

Hi, Nate.

I'd like to submit some public input to the RUAC, but I have an attachment. Here it is.

It's clear there is sizeable support for a trail along the Lower Road between Augusta and Brunswick, but there is also sizeable, though not as well organized, support for rail transportation between these communities. I would bet that that number of people willing to ride a train between Augusta and Brunswick is much greater than the number of people willing walk or bike that distance. And it's not just between those communities. It's Augusta and Freeport, Augusta and Portland, Augusta and Old Orchard Beach, Augusta and Boston, and so on, not to mention people from north of Augusta who want rail access to points south. As proof of support for rail along the Lower Road, I have attached a partial list of the people who have lent their support to the Maine Rail Group's petition for a full feasibility study of extending passenger rail service to Augusta, Waterville, and Bangor. The broad support for rail transportation is out there.

Whatever advice the Lower Road RUAC gives MaineDOT, MaineDOT must decide what comes next. With sizeable support for trail and for rail, the logical course is to take a direction that will enable rail and trail to coexist. In other words, plan for rail with trail. This way, advancement of one will not eliminate opportunity for the other. Removing tracks for trail takes away opportunity for rail. Ignoring the support for a trail along the Lower Road is a lost opportunity for trail interests. Rail with trail is the surest course for meeting the diverse interests in the Lower Road corridor. MaineDOT's Active Transportation Plan calls for developing, with local and legislative approval, trails on state-owned rail corridors. MaineDOT's State Rail Plan calls for the preservation of the integrity of inactive rail corridors and the planning for the future expansion of passenger rail from Brunswick to Augusta to Waterville to Bangor. The conflict between these two MaineDOT plans can be resolved by using a rail with trail approach.
