


Frank J. Wood Bridge Closure Begins Monday, May 14th

The **Frank J. Wood Bridge**, which connects the Brunswick and Topsham downtowns, will be **closed for essential repairs** starting **Monday, May 14th**. The closure is planned to continue through May 28th, depending on weather. This will be the last major traffic impact during this bridge rehabilitation project. The bridge will be closed to vehicles and pedestrians while the pavement is ground and the bridge repaved. MaineDOT plans to complete the work and reopen the bridge in time for Memorial Day weekend events.
