- 6,565 Crashes (5,300 Construction, 828 Maintenance, 437 Utility)
- 6 Fatalities (2 Construction, 2 Maintenance, 2 Utility)
- 2,628 Injuries (2,182 Construction, 294 Maintenance, 152 Utility)

### 2010 Maine Crash Data

- 560 Crashes (468 Construction, 54 Maintenance, 38 Utility)
- 3 Fatalities (3 Construction, 0 Maintenance, 0 Utility)
- 203 Injuries (185 Construction, 8 Maintenance, 10 Utility)

### Top 5 driver offenses in Maine for 2010 (Excludes "No Improper Action", "None" and "Unknown"):

- Driver Inattention/Distraction (183)
- Following Too Close (89)
- Illegal, Unsafe Speed (58)
- Failure to Yield Right of Way (50)
- Unsafe Backing (24)
