Summary of the activities of the board or commission related to accomplishing its mission in 2016: The purpose of the Public Transit Advisory Council is to provide insight and guidance with regard to public transit for the MaineDOT's stated mission which is: "To responsibly provide our customers with the safest and most reliable transportation system possible given available resources." In support of helping to achieve this mission the Public Transit Advisory Council reviewed the recommendations of the most recent Maine Strategic Transit Plan and considered methods to implement the recommendations. The central recommendation of the Maine Strategic Transit Plan was to revise how available funding is allocated through revised procedures and service methodologies with a renewed emphasis on service to the general public. To accomplish these revisions the Public Transit Advisory Council considered and advised the MaineDOT on a revised Transit State Management Plan (a State Management Plan is mandated by the Federal Transit Administration and must be approved before federal funds can be expended.) As part of the renewed emphasis on service to the general public the Public Transit Advisory Council also advised the MaineDOT on service to military veterans. The culmination of the first year of the activities of the Public Transit Advisory Council is a scheduled public hearing on the revised State Management Plan to be held January 12, 2017 at MaineDOT headquarters in Augusta, Maine.
