

# Identification of Project Types

## Type A Projects:

### **No potential for adverse environmental impact**

- Approved by Program Analyst.
- Categorical Exclusion (CATEX) under 44 CFR Part 10
  - Management and Administration (CATEX i),
  - Planning (CATEX iii),
  - Classroom-based Training (CATEX v),
  - Tabletop Exercises and Functional Exercises (CATEX v),
  - Training and Operational Exercises in Existing Facilities (CATEX v),
  - Purchase of Mobile and Portable Equipment (CATEX vi)



# Identification of Project Types

## Type B Projects:

### No potential for Extraordinary Circumstances

- Approved by GPD Environmental Specialist.
- Review indicates that the project will result in no adverse impacts on resources and that no consultation is required.
- Categorical Exclusions (CATEX) under 44 CFR Part 10
  - Physical security enhancements (CATEX xv)
  - Communications equipment and systems (CATEX ix)
  - Renovations/upgrades/modifications to structures (CATEX xv, xvi, xvii)



# Identification of Project Types

## Type C Projects:

### Potential for Extraordinary Circumstance(s)

- Review conducted by Regional Environmental Officer (REO).
- Agency consultations or coordinations may be required.
- If there are no adverse effects, REO issues a Record of Environmental Consideration (REC)
  - If the project is covered by the Programmatic Environmental Assessment (PEA) or a project-specific Environmental Assessment (EA) the REO issues a REC and Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI).
- If there are adverse effects the REO will work with the grantee to identify next steps.
