

MLTI Student Screensaver Artwork Submission Guidelines

Submitted artworks may be:

- Photography
- Photographs of art work (2 or 3 dimensional)
- Scanned works
- Digital art
- Due to the paperwork involved with identifiable human faces we will not allow any piece which will require model release forms. This means no photographs of recognizable human faces, please.

Submissions must be:

- Landscape orientation
- Digital format 1152x870 pixels
- Without images of people (which would require a model release)
- Submitted by December 23, 2011

When submitting:

- Label the files properly
 - Title of Artwork_StudentFirstInitial_StudentLastName_School_Teacher Initials
- Ensure files are the proper orientations/size, as files that are not properly sized will not be judged
- Artwork that is not properly labeled, sized or submitted on time, will NOT be judged. Students who submit more than piece of artwork will be not be included in the judging.
