

MLTI Student Screensaver Artwork Submission Guidelines

Submitted artworks may be:

- Photography
- Scanned works
- Digital art
- Photographs of art work (2 or 3 dimensional). If submitting photographed artwork, please read the **instructions** we've provided!
- Due to the paperwork involved with identifiable human faces we will not allow any piece which will require model release forms. This means no photographs of recognizable human faces, please.

Submissions must be:

- Landscape orientation
- Digital format 1152x870 pixels
- Without images of people (which would require a model release)
- Submitted by December 17, 2012

When submitting:

- Label your submission properly so we can easily find you. We will contact the teacher who in turn will let you know if you were selected.
 - Title of Artwork_StudentFirstInitial_StudentLastName_School_Teacher Initials
- Review the information we provided to ensure you have properly sized and labeled your image. Files that are not properly sized will not be reviewed by the selection committee.
- Students who submit more than piece of artwork will be not have their artwork reviewed. Due to an overwhelming number of submissions in early years, only one piece of artwork can be submitted per student.
