RE:	Bureau Bulletin No. 2018-01 Registration via an Independent Assurance Organization

An employee leasing company, as defined in Title 32, Chapter 125 §14051(3) may use the services of an independent assurance organization as approved by the Superintendent to register with the Bureau of Consumer Credit Protection ("Bureau").

Whether an employee leasing company authorizes an approved assurance organization to submit registration information to the Bureau on its behalf is entirely optional. Companies choosing not to use an assurance organization must continue to register using the Bureau's Employee Leasing Company Registration form.

Any company that elects to use an assurance organization to register with the Bureau is still responsible for complying with the Bureau regulations and any relevant administrative rules.
