**BUREAU ADVOCACY PANEL'S  
MOTION FOR ENLARGEMENT OF  
TIME WITHIN WHICH TO RESPOND  
TO APPELLANTS' FIRST  
INFORMATIONAL REQUESTS**

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
NOW COMES the Bureau of Insurance Staff Advocacy Panel appointed by the Superintendent and, pursuant to Chapter 350, §§ 5 and 7 of the Bureau's rules, states as follows:

1. On October 6, 2015, Appellants in this matter filed their First Informational Requests to the Advocacy Panel, requesting answers to certain questions and production of several classes of documents.
2. Pursuant to an Order of the Superintendent, the Advocacy Panel presently has until 5 p.m. on October 16, 2015, the tenth day after service of Appellants' Requests, to file its responses to the Requests.
3. Pursuant to Chapter 350, § 10(B)(4) of the Bureau's Rules, responses to informational requests are due no later than 14 days after the requests are received.
4. The Advocacy Panel has had to schedule several meeting to discuss the Requests, a sometimes difficult task in light of each member's other obligations. For example, what presumably would be the final such meeting was set for October 15 but had to be postponed because of the unanticipated unavailability of undersigned counsel.
5. The Advocacy Panel believes that with additional time to complete its responses to Appellants' Requests it will be able to provide more focused answers to Appellants' questions and more organized document productions.

6. Undersigned counsel has spoken with Attorney Matthew S. Warner, counsel for Appellants, who indicated that Appellants have no objection to this motion for enlargement of time.
7. WHEREFORE, The Advocacy Panel respectfully requests that it be allowed the customary 14 days for responding to informational requests, so that its responses would be due no later than 5:00 p.m. on October 20, 2015.
