

Roderick Small v. MMG Insurance Co.

The named insured requested a hearing to contest the cancellation of his automobile policy. The company cited the suspension of the driver's license of an operator who resided in the named insured's household as its basis for cancellation.

Held: For the company. 24-A M.R.S. §2914(4) permits the cancellation of a policy of automobile insurance if the driver's license of a named insured or any operator who either resides in the same household or customarily operates an automobile insured under the policy is suspended or revoked during the policy term. The company demonstrated that the driver's license of an operator who resided in the named insured's household was suspended during the current coverage period.
