NOTICE TO LICENSEES REGARDING 2014 RENEWAL APPLICATIONS

The Office of Professional and Occupational Regulation, Charitable Solicitations Program is pleased to announce that effective October 2, 2014 all charitable organizations and professional solicitors will be able to renew their professional licenses online. The Office will email renewal reminders to all licensees on October 1, 2014 – the email reminders will contain the organization name and access code.

The organization's access code and license number will be required to renew the license online. The access code is designed to verify the organization's identity and to protect its personal and professional information. Licenses may be renewed online, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, beginning 60 days prior to the license expiration date. Payment may be made with Visa or MasterCard. If you prefer not to renew online, organizations may use the online service to print the paper renewal for completion and submission to the Office.
