Administrator's Report

Association of State and Provincial Psychology Boards (ASPPB) Examination Program.

Administrator Betts discussed ASPPB Board of Directors decision made at their January 2016 meeting to approve the development and implementation of an examination to assess the competency-based skills necessary at entry-level licensure. The current Examination for Professional Practice in Psychology (EPPP) will be renamed the EPPP Step 1 and the new exam will be called EPPP Step 2. Representatives from the Association of State and Provincial Psychology Boards will be attending the meeting on August 2, 2016 to discuss the ASPPB PLUS program and State compact agreements between states for purposes of allowing a license to cross state lines to practice without obtain a license in the neighboring State.
