CALL TO ORDER

NEW BUSINESS

APPLICATION REVIEW

Edgar Martinez – Radiologic Technologist- Radiographer

Mr. Martinez submitted an application for licensure for a radiologic technologist, radiographer license. On the application he answered yes to the conviction question and disclosed multiple convictions.

After a full review and discussion, a motion was made by Ann Hall and seconded by Amy Houghton to grant the application for licensure.

Jaime Campbell – Radiologic Technologist- Radiographer

Ms. Campbell submitted an application for licensure for a radiologic technologist, radiographer license. On the application she answered yes to the conviction question and disclosed multiple convictions.

After a full review and discussion, a motion was made by Elizabeth Quate and seconded by Amy Houghton to grant the application for licensure.

Vote: 4 in favor

Jeffrey Taylor – Radiologic Technologist- Nuclear Medicine

Mr. Taylor submitted his application for relicensure of his radiologic technologist, nuclear medicine license. On the application he answered no to the conviction question and a criminal history record check revealed a 2008 conviction of Operating Under the Influence a Class D misdemeanor. In addition, he had failed to disclose the conviction on a subsequent renewal application.

After a full review and discussion, a motion was made by Ann Hall and seconded by Elizabeth Quate to preliminarily deny Mr. Taylor's application for licensure and offer a consent agreement in lieu of holding a hearing. The terms of the consent agreement are: licensee admits to failing to disclose convictions on his application for licensure and subsequent renewal application and acceptance of a formal warning from the board.

RULEMAKING DISCUSSION

02-465: Chapter 1

Torrey Gray presented the board with the proposed rules. Specifically, regarding a change to Chapter 1(3) which would clarify that Nuclear medicine technologist that hold a current ARRT certification in computed tomography that has been provided to the Board may use computed tomography for diagnostic purposes.

After a discussion and a full review, a motion was made by Elizabeth Quate and seconded by Ann Hall to initiate rulemaking.
