The Maine EIC is equal to 12% (25% for taxpayers with no qualifying children) of the federal EIC. The Maine EIC is refundable for Maine residents and part-year residents. The credit for nonresidents may not reduce the Maine income tax to less than zero.

Note: MRS may request additional information supporting the credit claimed before the return can be processed.

Special instructions for line 1. Certain taxpayers who are not able to claim the federal EIC may be able to claim the Maine EIC if you would otherwise be able to claim the federal EIC except that you (or your spouse, if married):

- 1) had no qualifying child(ren) during the tax year, and
- 2) were at least age 18 but under age 25 as of the last day of the tax year.

To determine if you are otherwise able to claim the federal EIC, see the instructions for 2020 federal Form 1040, line 27 available at www.irs.gov. First complete Steps 1 through 6 of the federal instructions except, check "Yes" in Step 4, question 2 if you (or your spouse, if married) were at least 18 years of age but under 25. Next, if you are eligible for the credit using these instructions, complete a pro forma federal Worksheet A - 2020 EIC - Line 27 (or Worksheet B - 2020 EIC - Line 27, if applicable).

Enter on line 1 above, the amount from the pro forma Worksheet A, line 6 (or pro forma Worksheet B, line 11, if applicable). Enclose a copy of the federal pro forma worksheet with your return.
