Overall---# CTE schools whose sending schools had fewer dissimilar instructional days on 2014-2015 regional school calendar vs. prior year: **15**

Overall---# CTE schools whose sending schools had same number of dissimilar instructional days (5 or fewer) on 2014-2015 regional school calendar vs. prior year: **2**

Overall---# CTE schools whose sending schools had increased number of dissimilar instructional days on 2014-2015 regional school calendar vs. prior year, but still fell within maximum of 5 such days allowed under law: **5**
