## For Heir (Maine Resident)

If you are an heir of a person who has died, and no personal representative has been appointed by Probate Court, you can transfer the title of that person's vehicle to your name by submitting a title application. This is completed by the immediate heirs, who may be: the person's children, parents, or siblings.

## What you will need:

- □ A Vehicle Title
  - If you cannot locate the title to the vehicle, you will need to file a Duplicate
    Title Application (<u>MVT 8</u>) in the deceased's name.
  - The fee is waived for a Duplicate Title Application in this case.
- □ Application for Certificate of Title (MVT–2)
  - An application for a Maine certificate of title can be obtained by visiting any of our motor vehicle branch or town office locations or by contacting the Title Unit in Augusta.
  - This is a \$33 fee.
  - If rush service is preferred, an additional \$10 rush fee will apply.
- □ An <u>MVT-22</u> completed by each heir.
  - This document must be notarized.
  - If the vehicle was financed, the heir must submit a lien release or obtain consent from the lien holder to title in the heir's name (MVT-27).
- □ A statement from the probate court that shows no will has been probated.
- □ A transfer of ownership.

\*If you intend to sell the vehicle, it is recommended that you first obtain the title in your own name.
